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Benefits of SWaM and Micro Certifications (continued)

Prime Contractor Small Business Subcontracting Plan

For procurements over \$100,000 unless a determination has been signed by the chief purchasing officer and supported by factual evidence explaining in sufficient detail why no subcontracting opportunities exist, all agencies and institutions shall include in the terms and conditions, the requirement for a Small Business Subcontracting Plan for the award of any prime contract. A DSBSD certified small business, which shall include women-owned and minority-owned businesses and businesses with DSBSD service disabled veteran-owned status when they have also received DSBSD small business certification who serves as prime contractor will receive full credit of the evaluation criteria for the Small Business Subcontracting Plan.

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<u>Small, Women-owned and Minority-owned (SWaM)</u> Certification

- > The Commonwealth of Virginia's small business program.
- > To enhance procurement and contracting opportunities for SWaM businesses participating in state-funded projects.





- > <u>Small Business:</u> No more than 250 employees OR No more than \$10 Million in gross receipts averaged over the 3-year period prior to certification application.
- > <u>Women-Owned Business:</u> At least 51% owned and controlled by one or more women who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens.
- > <u>Minority-Owned Business:</u> At least 51% owned and controlled by one or more minorities who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens.
- > <u>Micro Business Certification</u>: No more than 25 employees AND no more than \$3 Million in average annual revenue over the 3-year period prior to certification application.

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- ➤ Over 14,000 approved SWaM Certifications in the State of Virginia almost 700,000 businesses, 97% are small business
- **➢ Over 6,500 Micro Certified Businesses**
- ➤ In 2018 The Commonwealth spent 1.6B with SWaM businesses



- SWaM certification is now done online through our Certification application portal.
- > Paper applications will no longer be accepted.
- >Standard processing time is 60 business days from receipt of a COMPLETE application.
- >SWaM certification approval is good for five years.
